- 1. Period of deputation including period of deputation on ex-cadre post held immediately preceding the appointment in the same or any other organization/department of Central Government should ordinarily not exceed three year. The maximum age limit for deputation shall be 56 years on the closing date of receipt of application. The candidate must fulfill a "cooling off" period of 3 years from the date of his return from previous deputation.
- 2. All pay scales mentioned against he each post are pre-revised scales and the fixation of pay in respect of selected candidates, shall be in terms of notification of Government of India regarding Sixth Pay Commission.
- 3. The Tribunals are quasi-judicial bodies set up under the provisions of Recovery of Debts Due to the Banks and Financial Institution Act 1993. The deputation will be governed by the terms and conditions as contained in the DOPT's O.M. No.6/8/2009-Estt (Pat-II) dated 17.06.2010 as amended from time to time.
- 4. The number of vacancy may change at the time of filling of vacancies.
- 5. The candidates who apply for the post will not be allowed to withdraw their candidature subsequently.
